



LEARN HAND ENGRAVING

Hand Engraving: Focus on Lettering



In this hands-on practical one day workshop you will learn from a highly skilled professional engraver. The course, provided by the Hand Engravers Association of Great Britain, is aimed at improvers and those with experience of the craft.

Aims of the one-day workshop

This will be an introduction into engraving lettering, singular, eg. initials, or text for inscriptions. This is for students who have had some previous experience with engraving and will have some basic skills, and samples of their engraving.

Basic Techniques Covered

We will cover mainly two styles, a form of roman and script. The first is very blockish then the other a more cursive style as a contrast. Students who have a natural inclination to be able to draw will find it invaluable. Also we will show how the engraving can be repeated over and over from a master sample.

Format

- The course will run for one day 9.30am-5pm
- It is taught by a professional engraver, to a maximum class size of 8 students
- Students will learn through watching demonstrations by the course tutor and trying engraving for themselves, on copper supplied by the tutor
- Students should bring their own square graver, scorper (if possible), scriber, pencil and dividers. Any other equipment will be supplied by the tutors

David Bedford is a professional engraver with over 40 years of experience working to commission. Current owner of J J Bergin Ltd, an engraving firm established in 1894, he has a wealth of experience in all aspects of engraving. David is an experienced workshop leader, having taught at the Goldsmiths' Centre and for the Hand Engravers Association.

For this course, David will be assisted by his third year apprentice, Sarah Hobbs
